How was the violation discovered? It was reported to the Compliance Office on 10/6/11 by Assistant Men's Basketball Coach, Tim Buckley and Head Coach, Tom Crean.

List any self-imposed institutional action and/or conference action

Institution will count the impermissible contact as one contact, and withhold a second contact opportunity to satisfy the 2-for-1 penalty. As this was the staff's first contact with the PSA, this would leave one contact opportunity available for the 2011-12 academic year. Also, in accordance with case precedent and after a conversation between Ian Rickerby, Assistant A.D. for Compliance and Chris Strobel, NCAA Director of Enforcement, the institution will reduce the men's basketball recruiting person days by two for 2011-12 academic year, leaving 128 total. A letter of admonishment was issued to Coach Buckley.

Describe the facts associated with this request

On Wednesday night, October 5, 2011, Assistant Men's Basketball Coach Tim Buckley advised Head Coach Tom Crean that Coach Crean could have off-campus contact the next day (Thursday, October 6) with 2012 prospective student-athlete [redacted] at [redacted] high school, which subsequently occurred. Buckley had mistakenly believed that Thursday was the last day of the contact period. In fact, Thursday was the first day of the evaluation period. Coach Buckley realized the mistake on Thursday 6th, shortly after the contact had occurred, during a conversation with another IU basketball coach about telephone calls. The incident was immediately reported that same day (Oct. 6) to the compliance office by Coach Buckley (in person) and Coach Crean (via telephone). The compliance office contacted the Big Ten and NCAA regarding this the incident on that same day (Oct. 6).
